

Wyze Camera Settings for Glowforge Timelapse

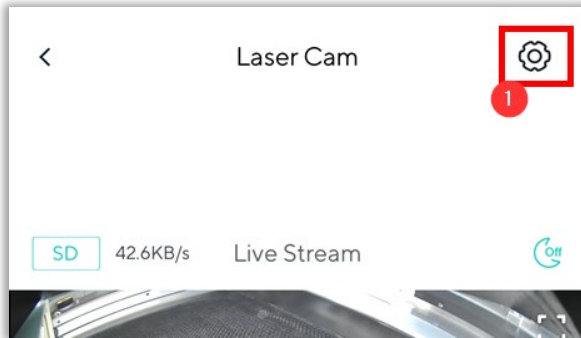
Set up camera following directions in box

Insert SD card

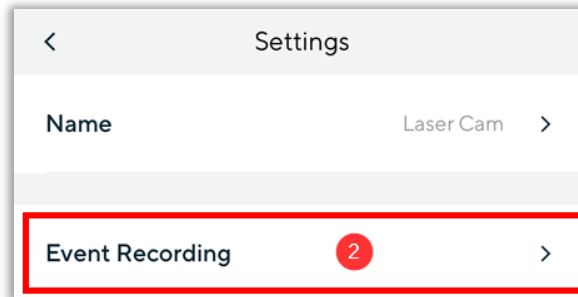


Open Wyze app and open camera

Open **Settings** (1) Icon

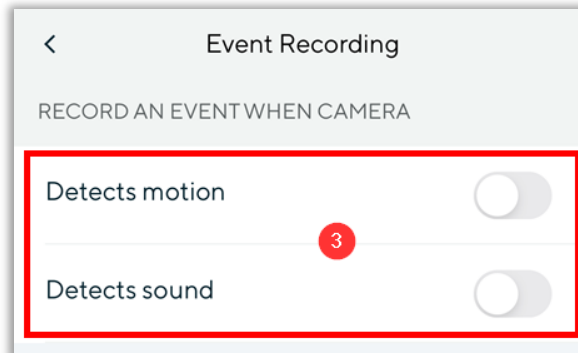


In **Settings** Menu Open **Event Recording** (2)



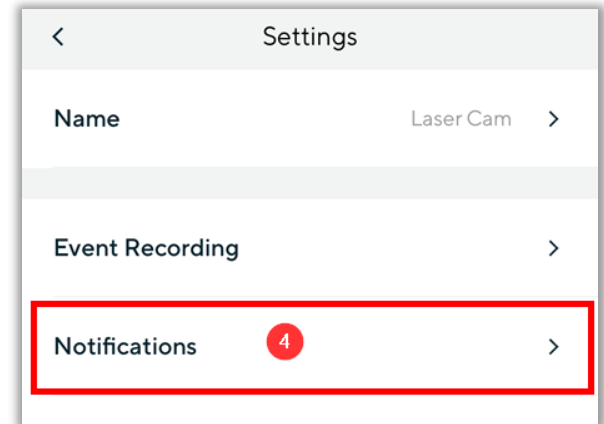
In **Event Recording** Menu (3)

Detects sound Off



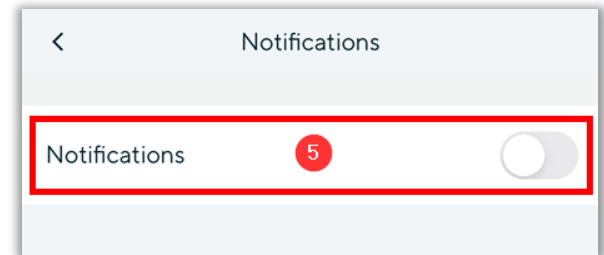
Return **back** one screen

In **Settings** Menu Open **Notifications** (4)



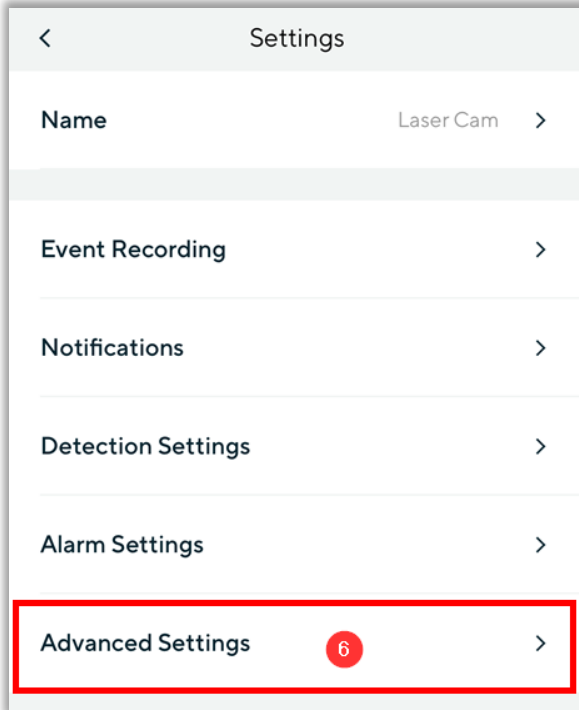
In **Notifications** Menu

Return **back** one screen

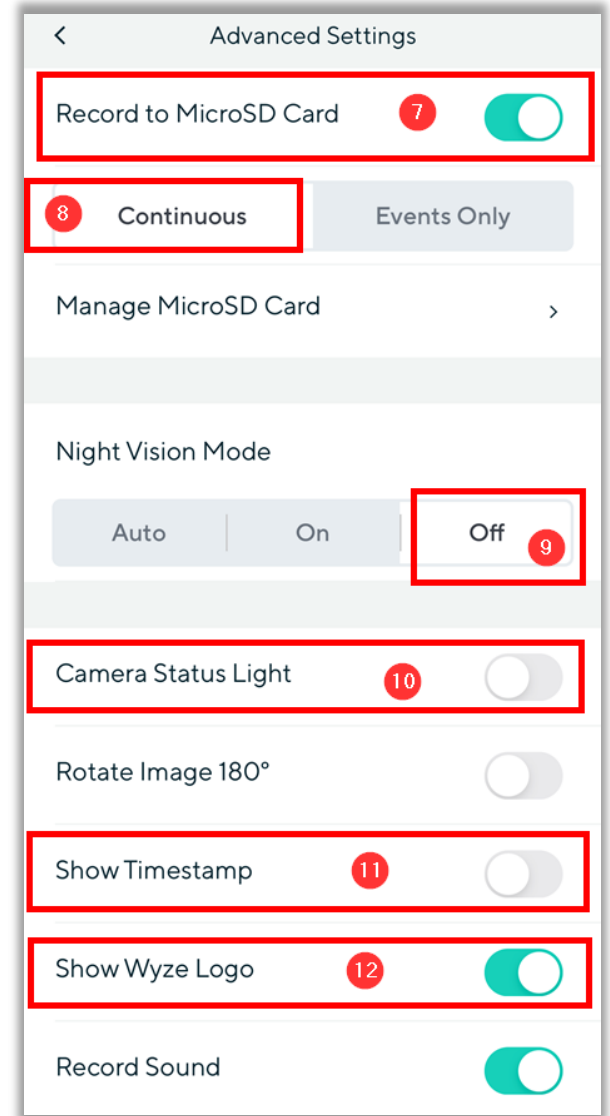
In **Settings** Menu Open **Advanced Settings** (6)



In Advanced Settings Menu

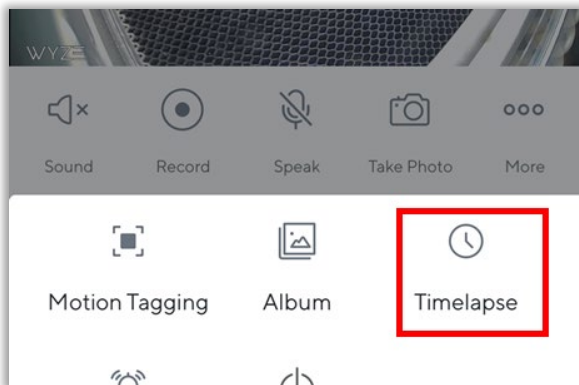
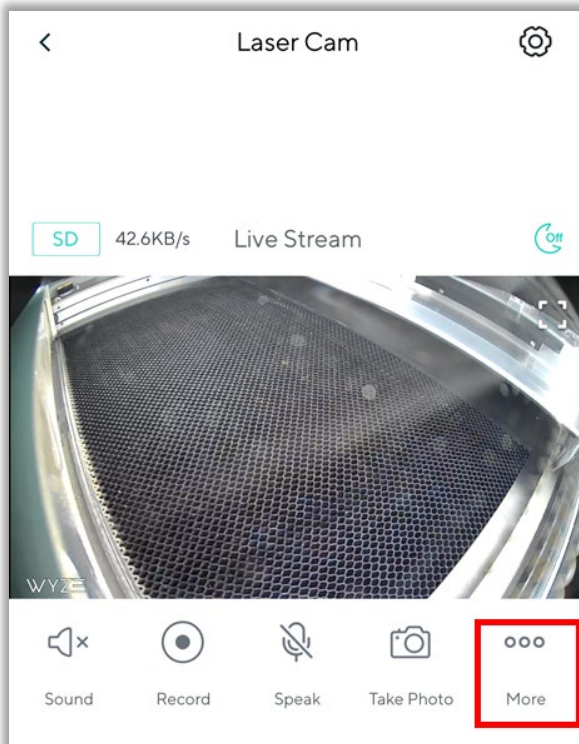
- Record to MicroSD Card** (7) On

Return **back** two screens to view camera

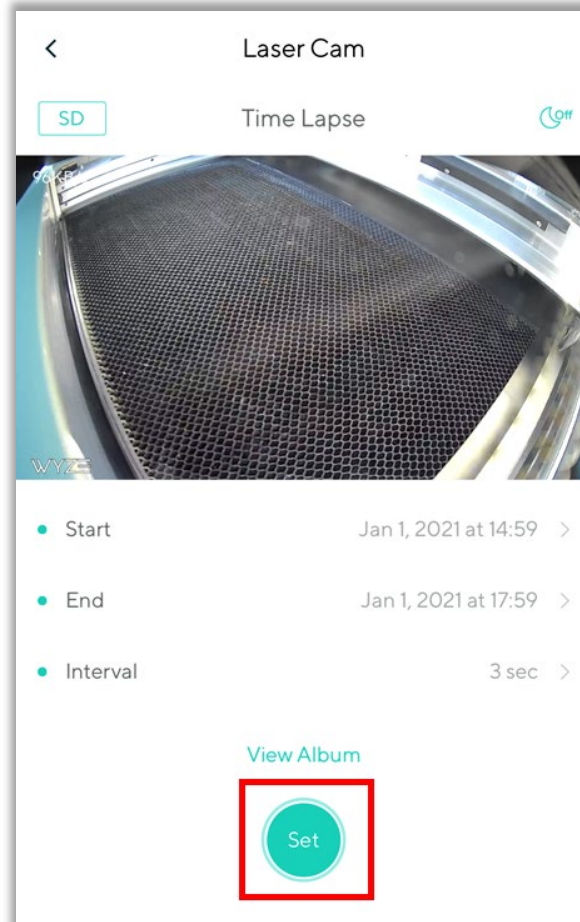


Start Wyze Glowforge Timelapse

Open **More** menu and open **Timelapse**



Adjust **Interval** and select **Set**



Note: For short jobs, I like the minimum value of 3 seconds.
For jobs running longer than an hour, you may want to adjust this to 5 or 6 seconds

Start Glowforge cut. Timelapse is recording.

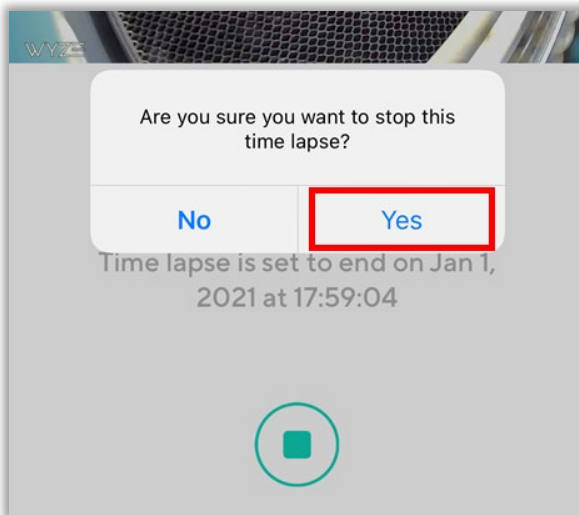
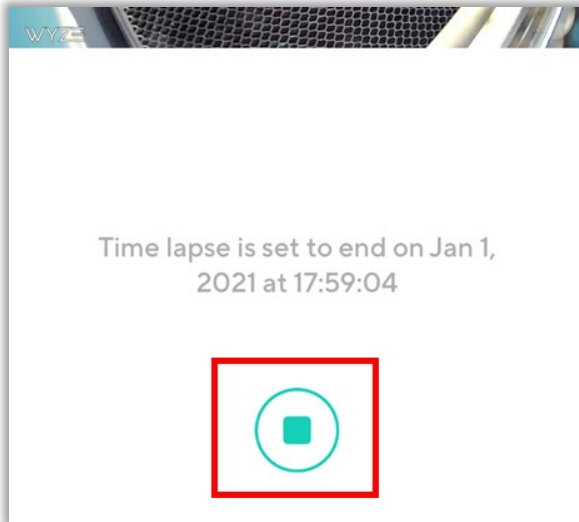
You may return **back** one screen while your job runs to watch for flame, or you may close the app entirely



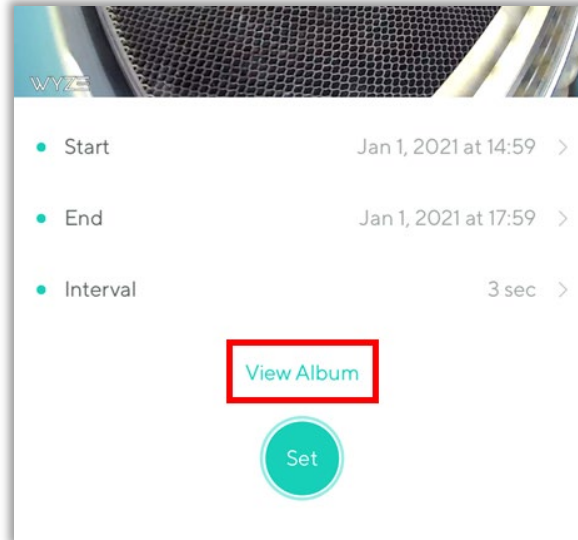
End Wyze Glowforge Timelapse and Retrieve Files

To stop timelapse, open camera, **More**, **Timelapse**

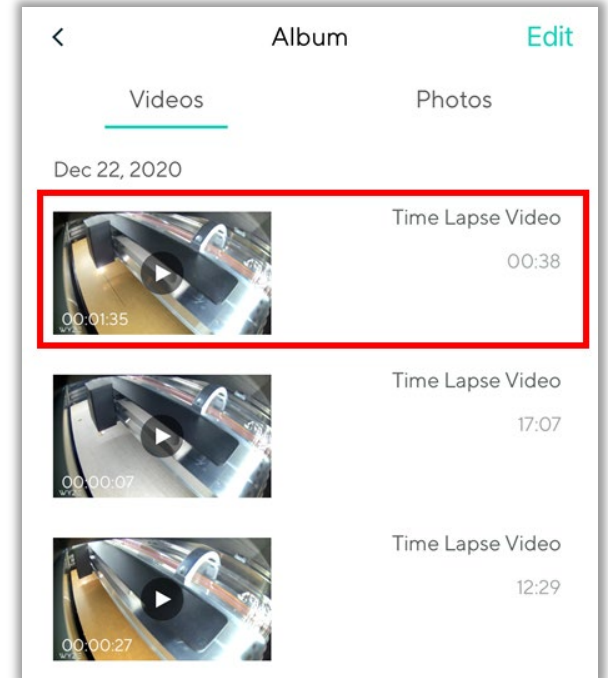
Tap the **stop** button and **Yes** to confirm



Open **View Album** to see recordings saved on the Wyze camera



Tap the recording you want and wait for it to sync over wireless to your phone or tablet



It will save to camera roll on your device where it can be edited and uploaded
